Introduction



National Cancer Clinical Nurse Specialist Day is a social media awareness day that has been developed to highlight and celebrate the hugely important role that the cancer nursing workforce provides in support of patients and UK-wide health systems on a daily basis.

The Cancer Nurse Specialist (CNSs) workforce is facing crisis. With the demand for cancer services increasing, more CNSs are needed now than ever before. Holding events like National Cancer CNS Day on 15th March is an important marker to celebrate the incredible work they do and myth-bust preconceptions around working in cancer **#NationalCancerCNSDay**

Last year the campaign received more than 3,300 mentions on social media and became a trending topic on Twitter, with a high level of engagement from CNSs up and down the country. Successful posts included a video featuring Amy, a cancer CNS, and her patient Marianne as well as a tweet featuring David Tennant on the value of the NHS as a whole, shared alongside a passionate message to protect the organisation.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

National Cancer CNS Day

What is a Cancer Clinical Nurse Specialist?

On average, someone is diagnosed with cancer every 90 seconds in England, and they seek the expert support of this profession. Cancer Clinical Nurse Specialists are experts in their field, offering a unique blend of skills to provide quality care to patients throughout the cancer pathway. They are pivotal in the coordination and delivery of personalised care interventions and offer support physically and emotionally.

Cancer clinical nurse specialists are highly regarded because of their specialist training and education and for choosing to work in an extremely demanding and complex field of healthcare.

What is National Cancer CNS Day?

The idea for a national cancer CNS day was born out of the knowledge that the growth of the cancer workforce is not keeping pace with the increasing demand for cancer services.

We know the Cancer CNS workforce is aging 18% of the workforce who are older than the general nursing personnel. Furthermore, 30% of CNSs are looking to retire in the next 8 years. Which means campaigns such as the National Cancer CNS Day are both important and urgent.

The Aspiring Cancer Career Education Development programme (ACCEND) was established to address and provide solutions to key issues that challenge the cancer workforce both now and into the future. The ACCEND programme is a key stakeholder and has committed to continue to support the National Cancer CNS Day after this was launched in 2022.

When is National Cancer CNS Day?

National Cancer CNS Day campaign will run every 15th March (or closest available date to it)

Who can get involved in National Cancer CNS Day?

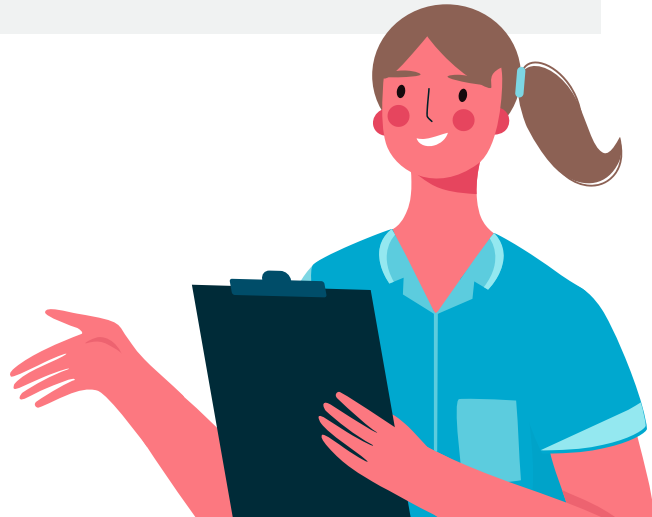
Everyone – if you have social media, feel free to join in ensuring to use #NationalCancerCNSDay.

Where is National Cancer CNS Day hosted?

This is a social media awareness campaign; therefore, the event will take place on social media platforms such as X (formerly known as twitter), Facebook, LinkedIn. It also allows people to share stories, pictures, and videos to raise awareness of this vital role but to also showcase the great work of our cancer CNS workforce. How can we get involved?

The overarching focus of cancer CNS day is for it to be an awareness raising social media campaign, so please use the messaging and posts in in this pack and join in with the scheduled thunderclap moment at 9am and 1pm.


Is there any funding available to support with content and in person events?

What is a thunderclap moment?

A thunderclap moment is a scheduled burst of activity that happens in support of a campaign. Essentially, everyone shares an X (tweet) at the same time, so there's a sudden surge in awareness (a thunderclap if you will) and the hashtags trend.

CNS Day on the 15th March shines a light on the wonderful work of cancer clinical nurse specialists (CNS) helping to support patients far and wide.

Years of evaluating the role has firmly established the CNS as an essential member of the multidisciplinary team in enhancing cancer care. CNSs use their expertise to assess, diagnose and treat people living with cancer and their role extends to other areas such as education and research

Responsibilities includes holistic support, specialist advice, symptom control and signposting to other services. CNS support can ensure people have continuity of care during their cancer journey as CNSs are usually the first point of contact when a patient requires any support and they continue to be involved in their care for many years.

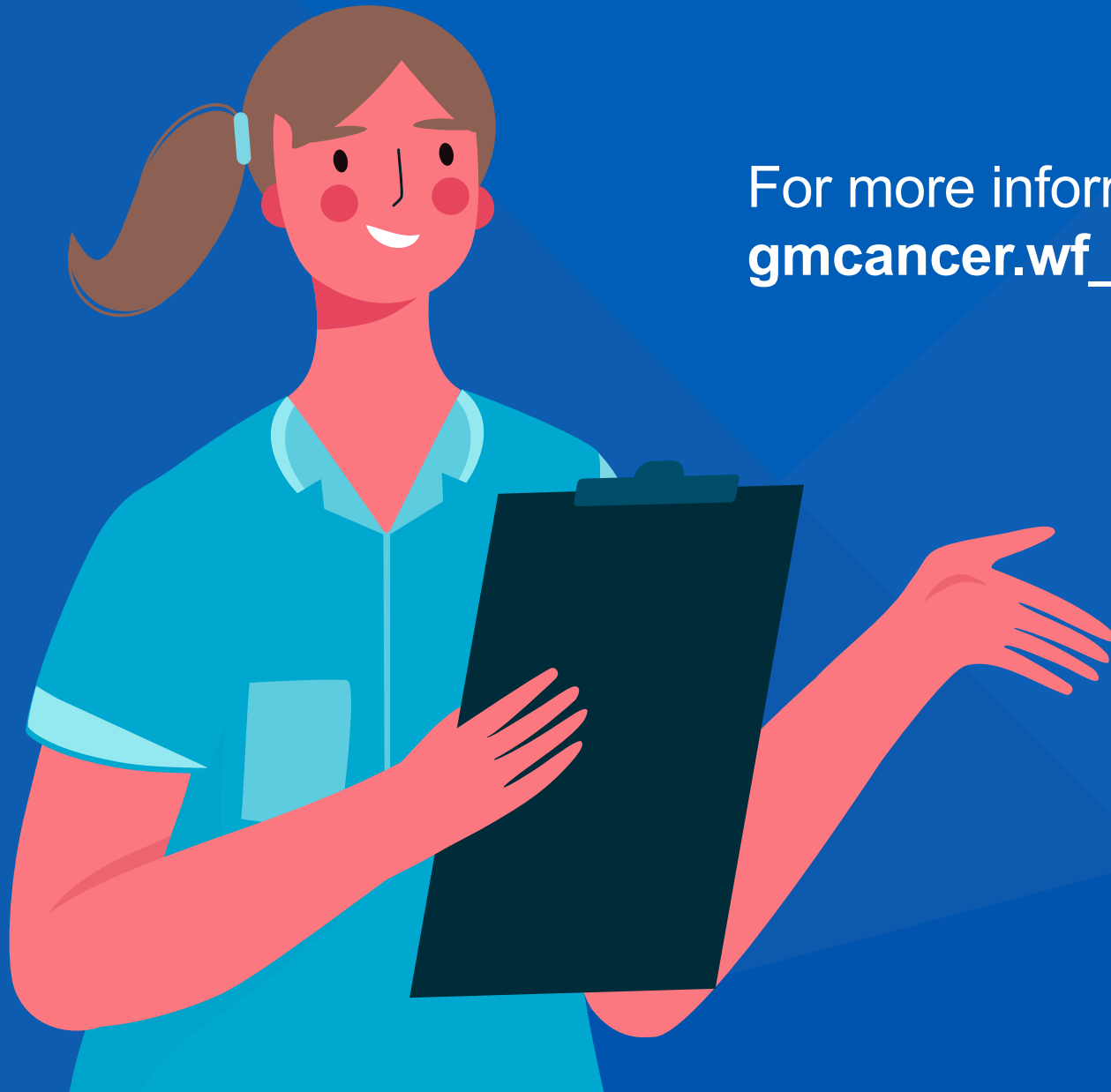
How to use
