What is cancer?	Beth yw canser?
Cancer starts in our cells.	Mae canser yn dechrau yn ein celloedd.
Cells make up the organs and tissues of our body.	Mae organau a meinweoedd ein corff wedi'u gwneud o gelloedd.
Each cell has a control centre called a nucleus.	Mae gan bob cell ganolfan reoli o'r enw niwclews.
A nucleus gets signals from the body to say when the cell should divide and grow and when it should stop.	Mae niwclews yn derbyn signalau gan y corff i ddweud pryd dylai'r gell wahanu a thyfu a phryd dylai stopio.
The nucleus then tells the cell what to do.	Yna, mae'r niwclews yn dweud wrth y gell beth i'w wneud.
Usually cells divide in a controlled way to make new cells.	Fel arfer mae'r celloedd yn rhannu mewn ffordd reolaidd i greu celloedd newydd.
When a cell is no longer needed or cannot be repaired, it gets a signal to stop working and die.	Pan nad oes angen cell mwyach neu does dim modd ei thrwsio, mae'n derbyn signal i stopio gweithio a marw.
Sometimes the signals go wrong and the cell becomes abnormal.	Weithiau mae'r signalau'n mynd o'r chwith a gall y gell fynd yn annormal.
